  - Does anyone have a written agreement with a localWorkforce Development Board that helps people experiencing homelessness access employment?
  - Does anyone have a written agreement with state or local education or training organization that prioritizes access to education or training opportunities?
  - Has any region promoted partnerships and access to employment opportunities such as job fairs, outreach to employers, or partnership with staffing agencies?
  - Has your region worked with public or private agencies to find volunteer opportunities for people experiencing homelessness?


