- Region V, Emergency Shelter, 11, emergency shelters in Region (Natl All End Homelessness)
 Housing First Principles: how that will be implemented in ES- Most effective are focused on
 housing first across the community. Trying to lower barriers into programs, quickly and
 permanently housed. Lowering barriers: (11 in Region)-utilization rate high. Shelters will
 need to make choices about who needs shelter the most. Diversion in communities, shelters
 not always equipped to handle high needs folks. Not enough COC resources, every program
 needs to think about how to get folks housed.

Looking at other housing resources, - assessments and the way you talk to clients, "being put on a housing waitlist". CE is Not a housing waitlist. It is a prioritization list. If there are people being assessed being high prioritized, they always will be chosen. Talk about what that assessment means, to figure out what those barriers are to housing, will work on services to get back into housing. *important to have that conversation while doing the assessment. – make sure expectations are set clearly.
