A020 Data Quality Monitoring Report

Updates!

- Agency reviews helped improve and correct the report
 - Date of Birth false flags gone
 - Annual Assessment false flags gone
 - Income and Sources at Entry, Interim, and Annual false flags gone



These make the report a better tool for you to track data quality



A020 Data Quality Monitoring Report

A note about Prompts

- Data is shared in different ways depending on project type and the 'need to know principle'
- Currently, running reports for your entire Agency can give you unpredictable data completeness results
- Use the A020 as a comprehensive Data Quality report for individual projects
 - Match Provider prompt to EDA Provider prompt for best results



A020 Common Errors

On the Fix These First! Tab

- Conflicting Relationship to Head of Household
 - Especially with multiple project enrollments (like in CE, and ES)
 - Confirm Rel to HoH is accurate for the Project Start Date of each enrollment
- Missing data for non-Head of Household members

On the HUD UDE Detail Tab

- Missing Annual Assessments
- Missing Disability "If Yes, long duration" sub-question



A020 Common Errors

On the NC UDE Income Detail Tab

- Missing DV Flee question for If Yes responses
- Missing NC County of Service
- Mismatch from Income updates

A020 - Data Quality Monitoring Report



Keep Running and Making Corrections to your reports!

- This was a Beta submission, but Data Quality is important all year round!
- Agency Admins and Program Leads should run the A020 Data Quality Monitoring Report:
 - At least monthly
 - Per project
 - Share the review and potential corrections across your teams
- Our next Monthly Training will review this report in its final version

New HMIS Data Standards are coming

- Updates occur every two years
- HUD's FY24 Data Standards will take place on October 1, 2023 (a Sunday)
- Key changes include:
 - More specific options for gender, race & ethnicity, exit destination
 - New collection requirements like sexual orientation for PSH, language preference
 - Updated HUD reports


- Data Center will prepare updated Paper Forms, Assessments inside HMIS, and Training
- Timeline for changes:
 - August for feedback and review of paper forms
 - September for training (alongside Annual Privacy Training)
 - October for full implementation
