## 4: Funding Update: ESG

- NC DHHS announced awards
- HMIS & Coordinated Intake projects funded
  - Potential for shifting money to other budget line items

### 5: Funding App Update: CoC

- NCCEH submitted CoC Registration to HUD Sept 23
  - Total Annual Renewal Demand (ARD)
    - Determined by GIW
    - \$5,131,987
  - Preliminary Pro Rata Need (PPRN)
    - Determined by geographic area + HUD formula
    - Will not receive this amount because of HUD cuts, sequestration
    - \$8,723,251

### 5: Funding App Update: CoC, Cont.

- Eligibility for 2014 Grants
  - 5 program components
    - 1. Permanent Housing
    - Includes Permanent Supportive Housing and Rapid Re-Housing
    - 1. Transitional Housing
    - 2. Supportive Services Only
    - 3. HMIS
    - 4. Prevention
      - Only for High Performing Communities, of which none exist

### 5: Funding App Update: CoC, Cont.

- Eligibility for 2014 Grants, Cont.
  - First-Time CoC Program Renewals
  - CoC Program Renewals
  - New Projects Created Through Reallocation
    - ONLY PSH and possibly RRH
  - Bonus points for administrative costs 7%
    - Less than 10% allowable

### 5: Funding App Update: CoC, Cont.

- Scorecard Committee & Project Review Committee
  - Each Regional Committee one representative on each
- Responsibilities of Scorecard Committee
  - Determines criteria and scoring guidelines for new and renewal project scorecards
- Responsibilities of Project Review Committee
  - Reviews and rates each project application according to the current scorecard
  - Recommends ranked list of project applications to the Steering Committee
  - Project applicants may not serve on this committee

#### 6: Workgroup Updates

- Data Usage
  - NCCEH staff contacting CHIN users not in compliance with No Fee License Policy
    - Reclaim license if unused/unwanted
    - Make a plan for user to comply with policy
  - NCCEH staff contacting all CHIN agencies to determine license demand
    - Complete and submit form by October 31:
