AHAR: Background

- Annual Homeless Assessment Report (AHAR)
 - Comprehensive report to Congress
 - Year-to-year trends
 - NC BoS submits data for entire CoC
- HUD will reject poor quality data
 - Does not include in AHAR
- Advantageous to have more NC BoS data in AHAR
 - Included in national conversation about homelessness
 - Access greatest amount of funding in CoC application



AHAR: Data Review

- It's time to review data to ensure we can include the most possible in AHAR
- In 2013, we submitted 6 table shells and 1 summary shell
 - 3 rejected by HUD
 - We aim to have 5 shells accepted this year



AHAR: Data Review

1. Null Values

- Missing data that needs to be completed
- How?
 - Data Completeness Report Card (v6, C2)
 - Review client files, update CHIN
 - Pay close attention to data elements less than 90% complete
 - Sometimes data is missing
 - Not ideal but true
 - Make no changes if you are unable to locate data
 - Missing is preferable to inaccurate



AHAR: Data Review

2. Entries and Exits

- Current and exited client entry and exit info
- How?
 - Enrolled Clients Count with Time in Program (v C1)
 - Clients with long length of stays actually enrolled for these long periods/still enrolled?
 - If not, exit clients when left the program



AHAR: Data Review

3. Overall Data Quality

- Detailed client info
- How?
 - CoC APR Detail (v18 C1.3)
 - Missing data
 - Non HUD assessment question values
 - De-duplicate clients

- To take effect October 2014
- Required online training
