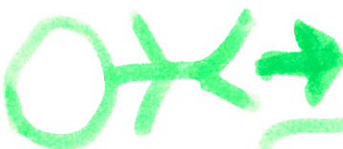


# Individual Adult in Need of Service

The four agencies below are designated entry points. An initial screening is done to determine if individuals can be redirected or prevented from becoming homeless.



**NC WORKS**  
• Does initial screening will attempt to provide services to help redirect/prevention.

**Eastpointe**  
• Initial screening  
• will attempt of refer to needed services if individual cannot be redirected.

**Goldsboro Housing Authority**  
• initial screening  
• Attempt to redirect/prevention and refer.

**Salvation Army**  
• does initial assessment  
• If can not be redirected and qualifies, keeps individual in shelter and will do VI-SPDAT in 14 days

If prevention or diversion is not possible, individual will be referred to a shelter. If shelter is available to keep individual, a VI-SPDAT will be done in 14 days and then determined how to assist individual

If individual qualifies, they will be referred for prevention/diversion services.
