Funding

Non-profit organizations and local units of governments that intend to submit a 2016-17 NC Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG) Project Application must submit contract certifications by Friday, October 7, 2016. Each contract certification should be submitted as an individually scanned attachment. As such, your electronic mail should include seven (7) attachments submitted to Sandra.Coley@dhhs.nc.gov. Receipt of applicant certifications does not imply funding approval.

To apply for 2016-17 NC ESG funding, agencies must submit a 2016-17 NC ESG Project Application and receive endorsement by a Continuum of Care/Region (CoC) for the area where service will be provided. Applicants are encouraged to contact CoCs/Regional Committees to inquire of ESG activity priorities, amount of available funding and the deadline to submit a NC ESG Project Application to CoCs/Regions.
