Roll Call and Review of Agenda

Approval of Meeting Minutes from November

• The committee reviewed the minutes from December's meeting. A motion was made by Christina to approve the minutes and it was seconded by Melissa.

January's Steering Committee Highlights

- All Regional Committees are asked to submit names and contact information for their leadership positions to NCCEH staff
- **Back@Home** formed in the aftermath of Hurricane Florence to administer a disaster re-housing program, using case management and housing navigation
 - O Disaster shelters have been closed since November 9th, but many affected by the hurricane are still displaces, in emergency shelters and on the streets.
 - Disaster survivors may call 211 to be screened for Back@Home. The 211 screening is not a guarantee of assistance
 - Emergency shelters may have clients being served by 3 agencies that are providing Back@Home services – Trillium, Volunteers of America and Southeastern Family Violence Center

• Point-in-Time Count

- The NC Balance of State CoC will complete accurate and comprehensive Pointin-Time and Housing Inventory Counts in 2019
- Regions should use the PIT count as a way to connect with folks who may be living unsheltered and offer to engage with them to help build rapport.
- Every region was expected to submit their Regional Committee planning Worksheet
 - Ensure that there is 100% coverage for the entire region; every count county should be counted
- o This year, an app will be used for the unsheltered count; shelter counts will either be through HMIS technology or non-HMIS agencies will have a paper survey
- Regions are encouraged to reach out to the Data Center for assistance with their PIT count questions
- o Region 11's PIT Lead is Erica McCloud
