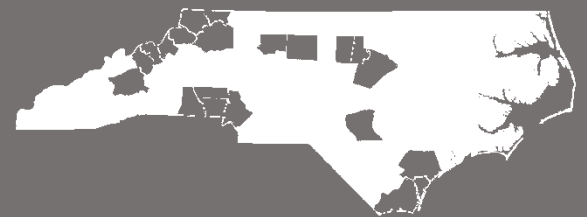


Racial Equity Subcommittee Meeting

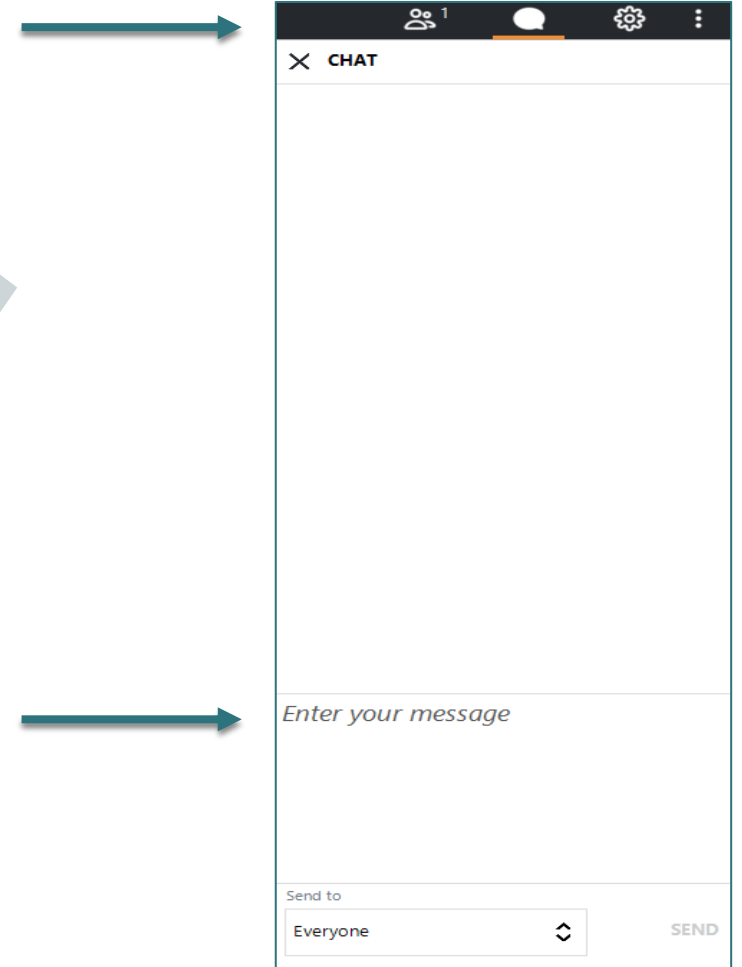

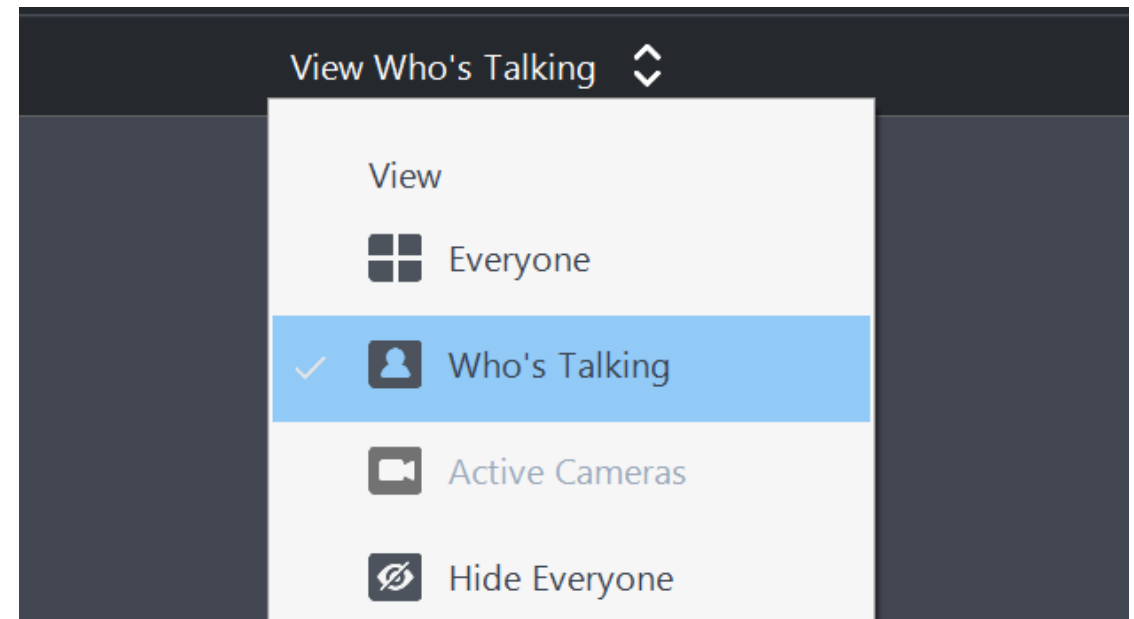
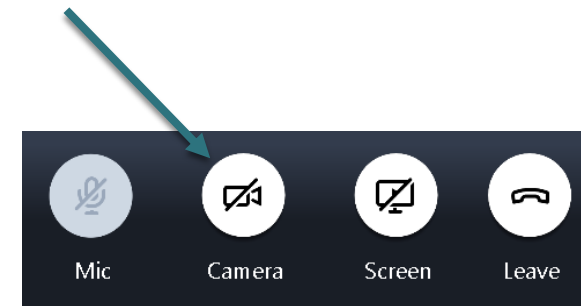

We have a lot of people! It may be easier to set the cameras to only show who is currently speaking. You can access this setting at the **top of the screen**.



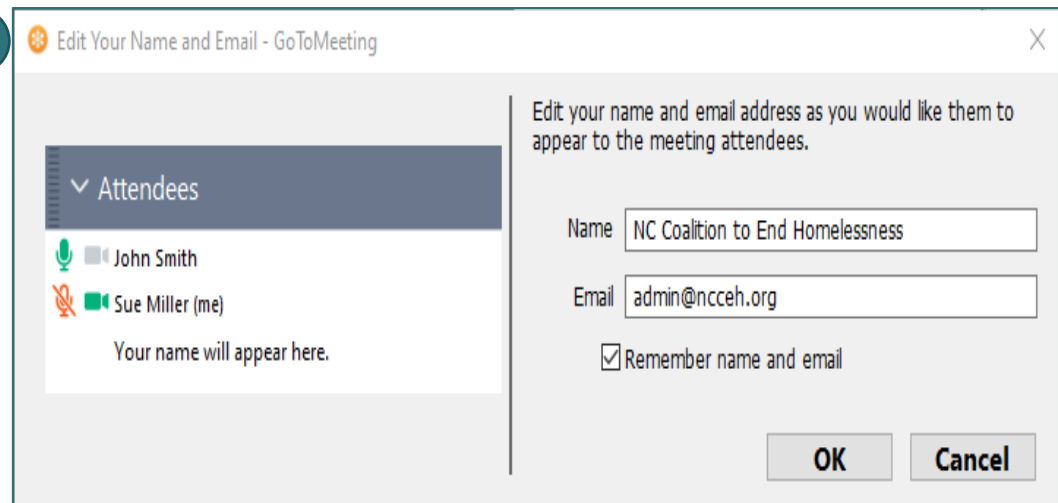

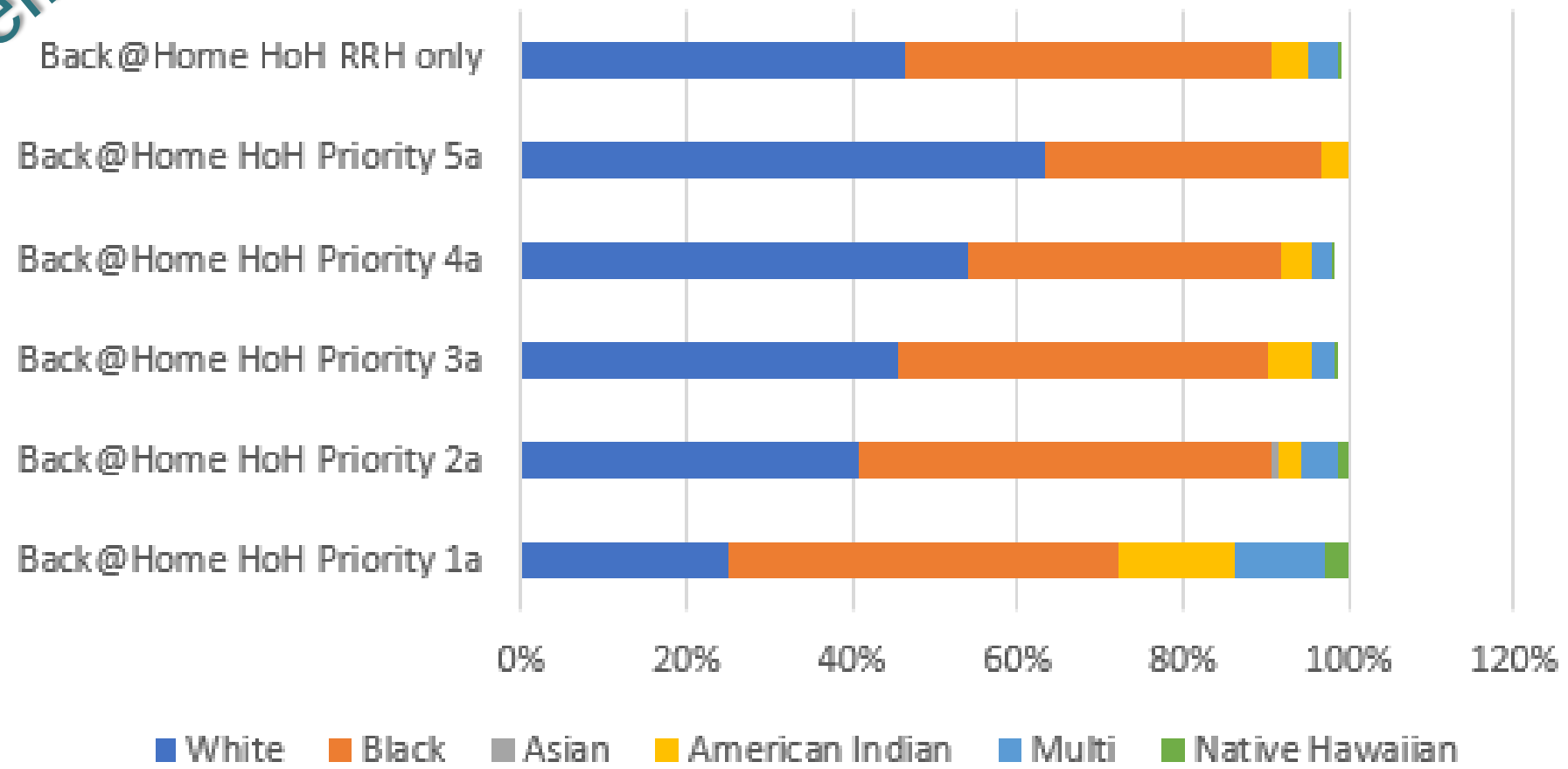


New Data on VI-SPDAT scores by Race



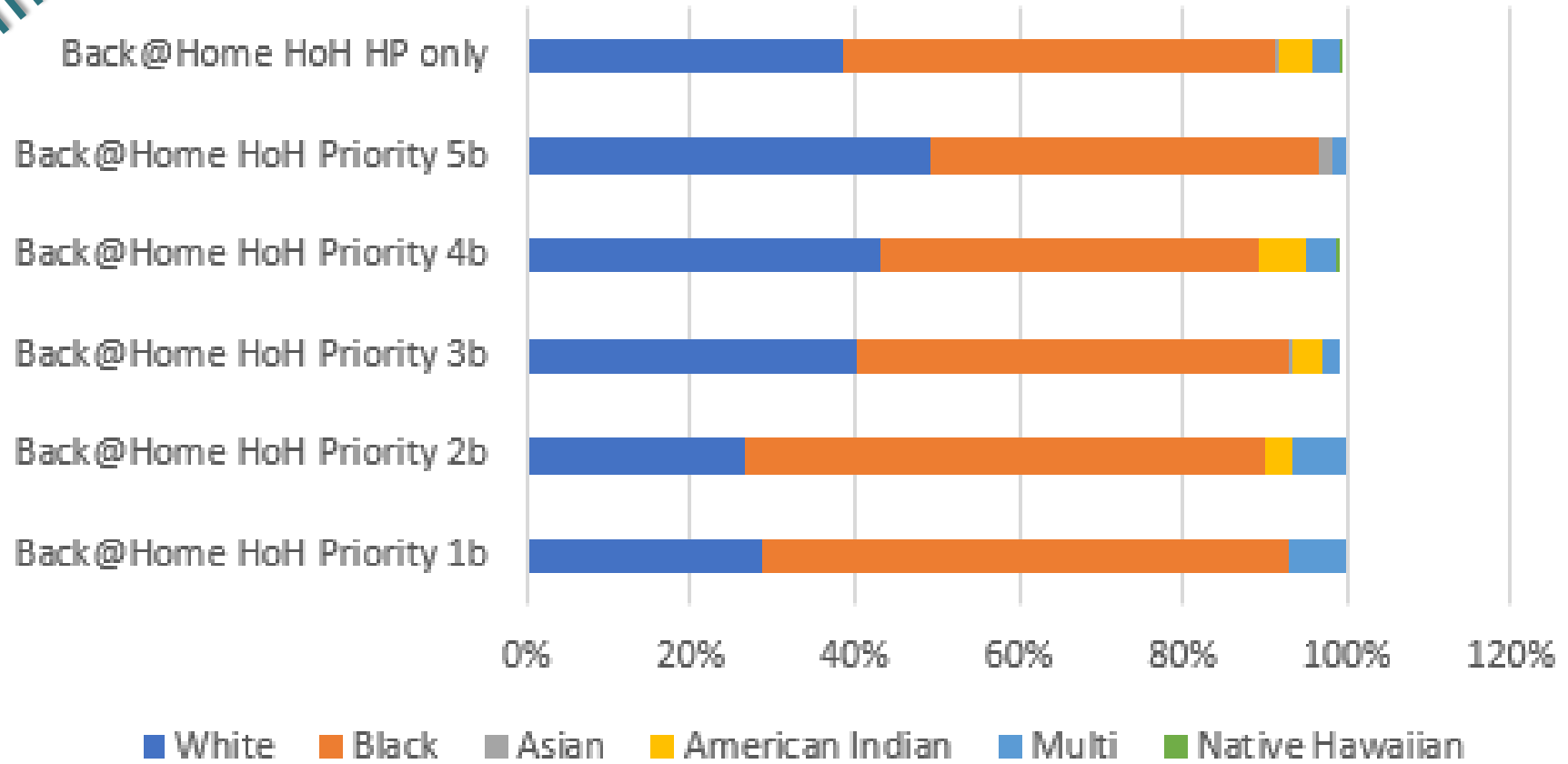

Back@Home RRH HoH



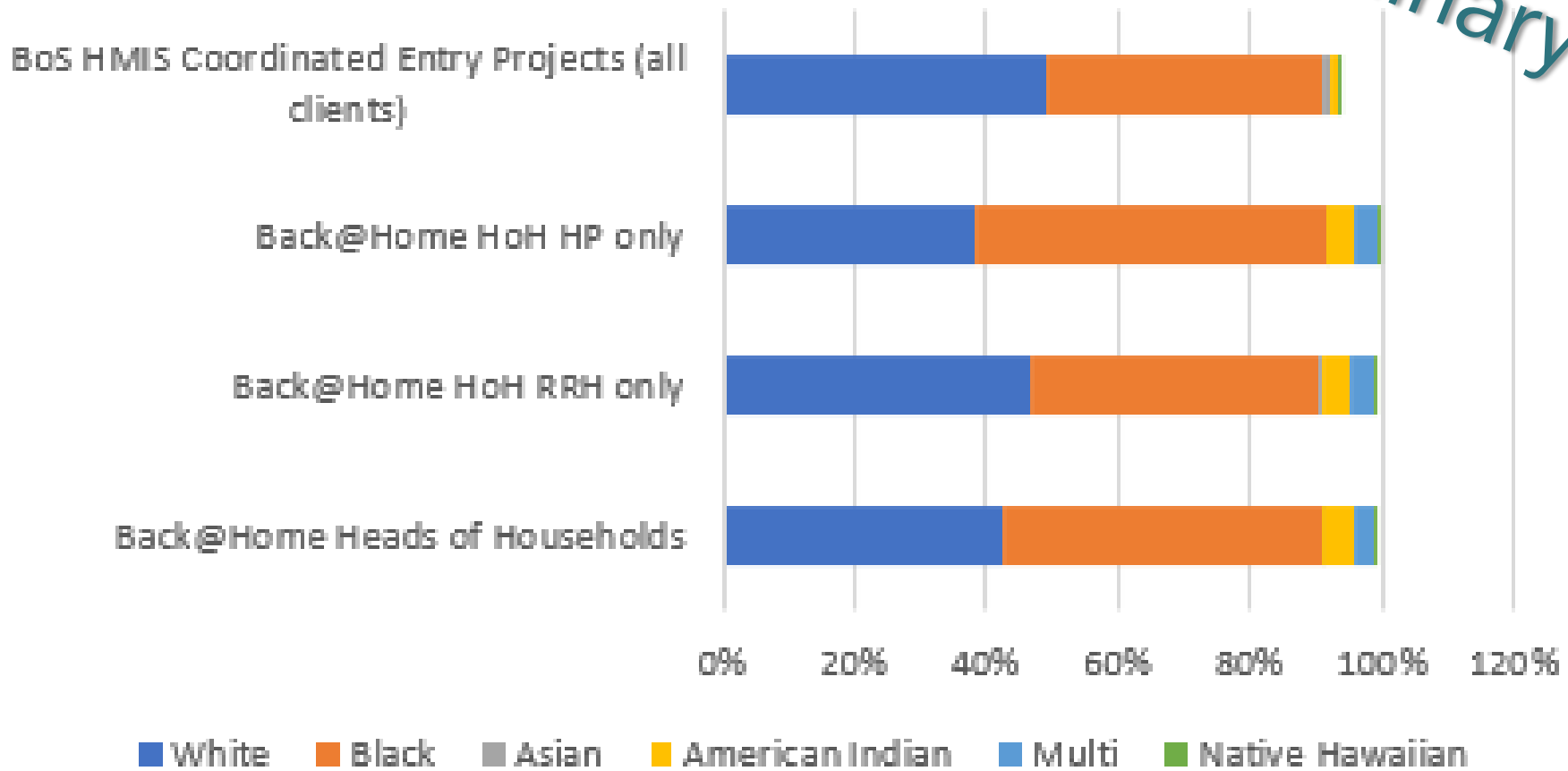

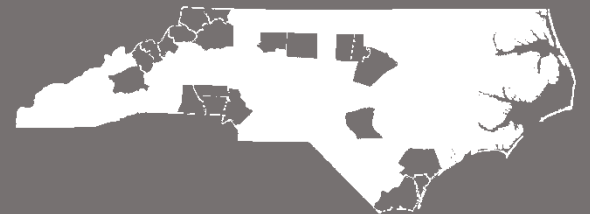

- Dialogues helped spread awareness, and start conversations at the provider level

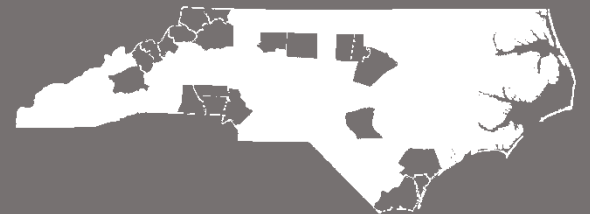


What still needs to be said?
