An at-large SC seat has opened mid-year

Rachelle Dugan stepped down from the Steering Committee when she took a new position with NCCEH.

Her at-large seat is open for the remainder of the year

- Term would be June December 2024
- Seat reserved for persons with lived experience of homelessness (PLE)
- Not restricted to one region of the CoC



Precedent in filling mid-year vacancy

In the past, if an at-large seat opens mid-year, it is filled by someone in the same agency that employed the departing member.

This precedent doesn't apply in the case of PLE seats.

Rachelle was a member of the Lived Expertise Advisory Council (LEAC). To fill this seat, the LEAC would propose nominating another subcommittee member to serve the remainder of the term.



Nominating Karen Carroll



Karen Carroll has served on the LEAC since January 2024 & was recently elected as co-chair of the LEAC.



She presented at the NC Bringing It Home Conference in 2024, alongside other members of the LEAC.



She is an active participant in the Region 06 regional committee.

 Back@Home Balance of State
 - Already have a contract system in place and experience doing this work with local providers to implement grants
 - Can meet match requirements, especially noting the large match for Northern PSH Combo

When is the Regional Review Form completed?




The Regional Review Form will be sent to Regional Leads & Alternates as early as we can, Wednesday, July 17, 2024.



The Regional Review Form needs to be completed & returned by the deadline of 5 PM on Tuesday, July 30th to be considered by the Project Review Committee to create the proposed slate of applications & for NCCEH staff to complete the regional application.



Regional Review Form



Hold a Regional Committee meeting between July 17th & July 30th.

The meeting or the portion of the meeting addressing this form must be facilitated by a leader who does not have
a conflict of interest.

Areas in yellow need to be completed:

- Regional Webmasters & CE Leads need to find this data ahead of the Regional Committee meeting!
- Yes or No has the applicant agency staff attended at least 75% of Regional Committee meetings?
- Yes or No has the applicant agency attended at least 85% of case conferencing meetings?
 - Agencies new to ESG Program funding in this year's competition who aren't attending CE, should be
 explaining how they will be attending case conferencing meetings once awarded ESG Program funds.
- Consistent with the past two competition years, no funding amounts will be included.
- Yes or No does the regional committee recommend each project for funding? And why?



No CoC Participation Form This Year!

- In the past few competitions, there has been a CoC Participation Form required of applicants that were approved by the CoC to submit applications to the NC ESG Office.
- Each agency was asked to gather information & provide signatures from Regional Leads before submitting their final application documents to the NC ESG Office.
- Now this information is collected in the project application or regional application. It is critical that we receive the Regional Review Forms so we can put the information needed in the regional application.





Conflict-of-Interest Policy

- Persons attending Steering Committee or Regional Committee meetings representing an agency applying for CY2025 ESG Program Funding may <u>not</u>:
 - Participate in conversations about applicants
 - Facilitate Regional Committee meetings to recommend agencies for funding
 - Ask questions about the funding proposal for your agency
 - Make a motion related to approving or recommending an agency for funding
 - Represent the region on the Project Review Committee
 - Vote on the Regional Review Form or proposed slate of applicants (Steering Committee meeting only)




Avoiding a Conflict of Interest





People Experiencing Sheltered Homelessness



Unsheltered PIT Count uses HMIS coordinated entry data entry:








People Counted in PIT, 2020-2024


Total People Counted by Region 2024

Total People Counted by Region 2024








Combined PIT Count








PIT Across the NC Balance of State CoC

Total Unsheltered People Counted by Region 2023-2024











PIT Across NC Balance of State CoC: Subpopulations






PIT Across NC Balance of State CoC: Subpopulations


Total Chronically Homeless Counted up to 572 from 253

■ Non-Comparable VSP



Non-HMIS




HMIS Bed Coverage

Total Percent on HMIS




HMIS Bed Coverage – changes without VSP
