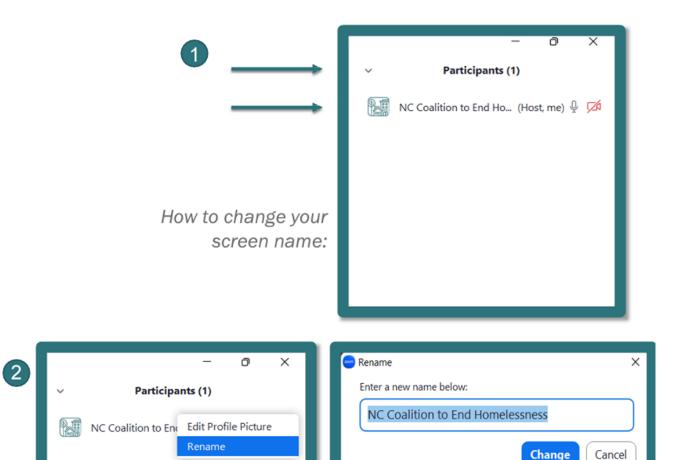

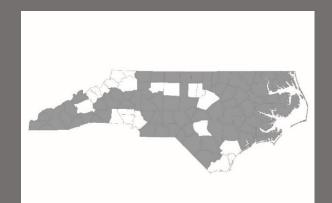



Unsheltered PIT




2024 Unsheltered PIT

- HMIS Data Center sent emails to each Region
- Excel spreadsheets contained households in HMIS with a Current Living Situation of Place Not Meant for Habitation and a Current Living Situation date of 1/31/2024 (PIT Night)
- If no contact can be made with these household, please:
 - Advise the agency who entered them to exit them for their project
 - Exit the household from the CE project


- Households may show a HART Score even if they have NOT been assessed with HART

- Uncheck the box for Blanks
- Then only households who have had a HART will show on the BNL

Transition from VI-SPDAT to HART

- Six months to allow for clients to be re-assessed with HART
 - VI-SPDAT scores will be removed from BNL after Dec 31st
- For each available referral, alternate between prioritizing with the HART and the VI-SPDAT
- Want help phasing in the HART? NCCEH can recommend segments of clients on the By Name List to start with!



Transition from VI-SPDAT to HART (VSPs)


- Instead of email communication, VSPs will be given a Smartsheet Form to submit the HART
 - CE Leads will be sent a copy of the results via email (immediately)
 - No identifying information is needed



2024 CE Evaluation Process

Working with the Lived Expertise Advisory Council to update the process.

- During the February LEAC meeting we discussed an overview of coordinated entry and the coordinated entry evaluation
- In March we reviewed questions from each of the surveys to determine if they were valuable, needed to be asked in a different way, or should be deleted from the survey.



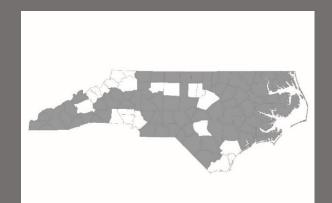
2024 CE Evaluation Process





 - CE Events (like Permanent Housing Referrals)
 - Housing Move-In Date




Should we move forward with Dynamic Entry/Exit sharing?

Veteran CE Integration

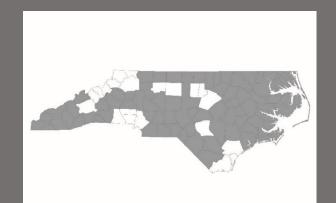


CE referrals to Permanent Housing

- V5 NC BoS 2024 Q1 BNL (beta testing)
- Q1 Veteran Data
 - 223 Veterans have an HMIS Project Entry
 - 22 recorded referrals to PH from CE, 2 of which are SSVF
 - 24 CE Exits recorded
 - 5 recorded as permanent housing placements
- Discussion Questions
 - Does this appear accurate?
 - What are the challenges/barriers?

Back@Home Reminders

- CE Referrals to Back@Home
 - Are providers asking for referrals during case conferencing?
 - Are providers receiving enough referrals through CE?
- Please ensure referrals to Back@Home are the most appropriate referral for the household.
 - A client has identified as a Veteran. Refer to SSVF and/or HUD VASH.
 - A household is fleeing domestic violence. Refer to Safe at Home
