Eligible Activities:

- Housing relocation & Stabilization Services
- Data Collection & Evaluation
- Financial Assistance

Timeline

- ConPlan substantial amendment due to HUD 5/18
- HUD approves substantial amendment no later than 7/2
- HUD signs contract with the state and entitlements no later than 9/1
- State has signed contracts with sub-grantees no later than 9/30

PIT, HMIS & eHIC

- For Point in Time (PIT) count, all shelters in communities must submit PIT (even if not receiving HUD funding). This data is used for BoS application. Check to see PIT counts submitted: <http://www.ncceh.org/BoS2009PIT/>
- The number of beds you record in HMIS should match the # of beds in the Electronic Housing Inventory (eHIC); we submit the eHIC for the BoS application.
- The HMIS & eHIC #'s should be those beds that are “reserved” for that specific population.
