HUD Dates & Updates

- NOFA anticipated August 24, 2009
- Information for HUD Worksheet – we'll be contacting agencies to collect needed information.
- All grantees awarded in 2002 must be renewed this year

HUD Changes for this Year

- Renewal awards will be announced in Fall 2009 & New awards in Spring 2010
- Con Plan certificates will go with Exhibit 1 not separately in Exhibit 2
- Process expected to coordinate with ARRA
- Housing emphasis and leveraging will only count for new projects

HUD Changes Con't

- SHP and S+C can apply for 100% FMR only; no overage
- PH Bonus is not limited to chronically homeless (but CoC's are encouraged to use some for chronic)
- All grants awarded in 2002 cycle must be renewed this year!

Homeless Prevention & Rapid Re-housing Program (HPRP)

- HPRP Request for Application (RFA) due to at the Office of Economic Recovery & Investment (OERI) **August 7th**
- Visit www.ncceh.org to review & download RFA
- Local Approval: Agencies submitting HPRP application must document their collaboration with local CoC or 10 year plans in developing their HPRP application.
- BoS communities have the option of presenting their projects before their local/regional committee *or requesting a subcommittee of BoS to review.*
- Letter of support from 10 yr plan or local/regional CoC needed for application

HPRP Local Approval

- Identification of partners not already engaged and assistance in drawing those partners into the project
- Identification of opportunities to leverage additional resources
- Review of 10year plan/CoC goals and analysis of how the HPRP project can best help further those goals
- Assistance in maximizing collaboration to ensure that only one entity will submit an application covering a geographic region.

Local CoC Committee/10 Yr Plan HPRP Letter of Support should include:

- Recommendations made by the committee to improve the project
- Opportunities for the project to help further the committee's goals/plans
- Strengths of the project identified by the committee
- Any weaknesses of the project identified by the committee
- Other information the committee would like the State to know about the project.

Remember: only one application submitted per region
