3: Funding App Update: ESG

- NC BoS Approval of ESG Apps
 - Same funding as previous year = approved
 - New RRH & prevention = approved if meet State's scoring threshold
- All other projects, closer review & provide feedback to State
 - Onslow, Piedmont, Transylvania: HMIS, Coordinated Intake

3: Funding App Update: ESG, Cont.

- Issues with Regional Applications:
 - Craven, Randolph: housing stability minimum not met
 - 5 regions asked for more than their allotted share
 - Lee and Carteret are not official BoS regional committees.
Any funding they receive will be conditional on these regional becoming official BoS Regional Committees in January.
- Targeted feedback on applications
 - Call Amy Cole (in October, not now!) to schedule optional consult call

4	Field offices finalize GIW with CoC	Sept 19
5	FY 2013 CoC Registration closes	Sept 23

4: Funding App Update: CoC, Cont.

Total CoC Score with Bonus Points	134	105.55

5: Data Usage Workgroup Update

- Policy to maintain no-fee license
 - Log in at least once every 60 days
 - Maintain a HMIS rating of 80 or higher (as determined in the Monthly Data Quality report) or be actively working with CHIN to improve HMIS rating
 - Enter all HUD required elements in CHIN
 - Be responsive to outreach from CHIN and/or NCCEH
 - CHIN User or other agency representative regularly participate (80% or better attendance) in his or her local Balance of State Regional Committee meetings
 - Participate in BoS Data Quality Subcommittee

5: Data Usage, Cont.

- Going forward
 - BoS will contact CHIN users who are not in compliance to:
 - Reclaim the license if unused/unwanted
 - Make a plan for user to comply with policy
 - BoS will also contact all CHIN users to determine license demand now-June 2014
 - Look for communication in the coming weeks

6: CA Workgroup Update

- Met in August
- Framed the task
 - Written standards/guiding principles
 - Potential recommendations for scope, implementation, model, etc.
- Plan to have recommendation for Steering Committee in November

7: BoS Representation

- Elect Regional Lead alternates
 - Able to vote if Regional Lead is absent/has conflict of interest
 - Alternate election must be reflected in minutes
- Submit Conflict of Interest forms for both Regional Lead and alternate
 - Pages 14-15 of Governance charter
- Election for CHIN Advisory Committee BoS Regional Representative
 - Also serves on Data Usage Workgroup
