ESG Intent to Apply Form

- Form for agencies to express their interest in applying for ESG funds
- Regional Committee can opt to use this form
 - To help organize expected ESG applications
 - To help agencies think through funding request
 - Not required
- NCCEH will share submissions with Regional Leads
- NCCEH will not make contact with applicants – this is responsibility of each Regional Committee

RRH in PIT/HIC

- RRH households do not count as homeless
- Report in Housing Inventory Chart (HIC)
- Only households who are:
 - Enrolled in a RRH program
 - In a unit, receiving rental assistance the night of the point-in-time count



Rapid Re-Housing Workflow for HMIS

- Client Profile
- Households
- ROI
- Add Entry
 - All clients must be entered into a program of an agency
 - Complete for each household member
- Service Transactions
 - Must be AFTER the entry date and BEFORE the exit date
- Exit Client
 - Complete for each household member



Service Transactions

- One Time Payments
 - Start Date = Date the payment was made.
 - End Date = IDENTICAL to the Start Date
- Rental Payment Assistance (utility deposits or payments, arrears, etc.)
 - Start Date= FIRST day of the month covered by the rent
 - End Date = LAST day of the month covered by the rent.
 - Make sure to enter the exact dates



Tracking Rapid Re-Housing Clients

- PIT data
 - Clients entered correctly
 - Less than 10% missing universal data elements
- Length of time homeless
- Learn more about who we are serving
 - Household composition
 - Employment and income
 - Reason for homelessness
- Tracking households at 3, 6, and 12 months of program exit
 - Returns to homelessness
