WCDSS: WCDSS mailed out a number of advanced applications for the December LIEAP applicant population and are seeing success with a large number being returned. Application will be processed effective December 1st. December 1 is also the opening day for people 60 years of age or older or people over 18 years of age who are disabled (and receiving DAAS Services) to apply. January 1, 2015 is the date that the LIEAP application process opens up to all Wilson County Residents. Those applying must have a heating source/account in their name or be responsible for paying a heating account bill at their residence. There is an eligibility criterion thus those eligible to apply will be assessed utilizing the CIP/LIEAP state system. Those eligible and approved will receive an energy credit with the payment made directly to their heating account. It is taking about 3-4 weeks following approval for the credit to post to the account thus customers are being instructed to stay abreast of their heating bills to assure they are making the necessary payments.

Wesley Shelter: The Wesley Shelter is coordinating food assistance and helping people for the holidays. The cloths line store is opening back up next week after moving to their new location (403/407 Nash Street, Wilson). March 28, 2015 is the scheduled date for the Soles Challenge date.

Family Endeavors: Family Endeavors is working on a new brochure to illustrate the work they are doing. They are able to work with people in Wilson County.

Hope Station: Hope Station reported that they do not have the final approved ESG contract yet and they are waiting to hear from the Balance of State but are hopeful that it will forthcoming soon. There is an initial report due to the Balance of State, reflecting on last years statistics compared to this year projection. Their social worker starts December 1st and Amanda Flory who worked the previous ESG grant as agreed to help with the training of the new person on a limited/part-time basis. The Hope Station is holding a toy distribution on December 16th. Hope Station is also orchestrating a turkey distribution and this information will be available soon.

Eastpointe: The Shelter-Plus Care program is underway and they have 4 unites that they will be filling.
