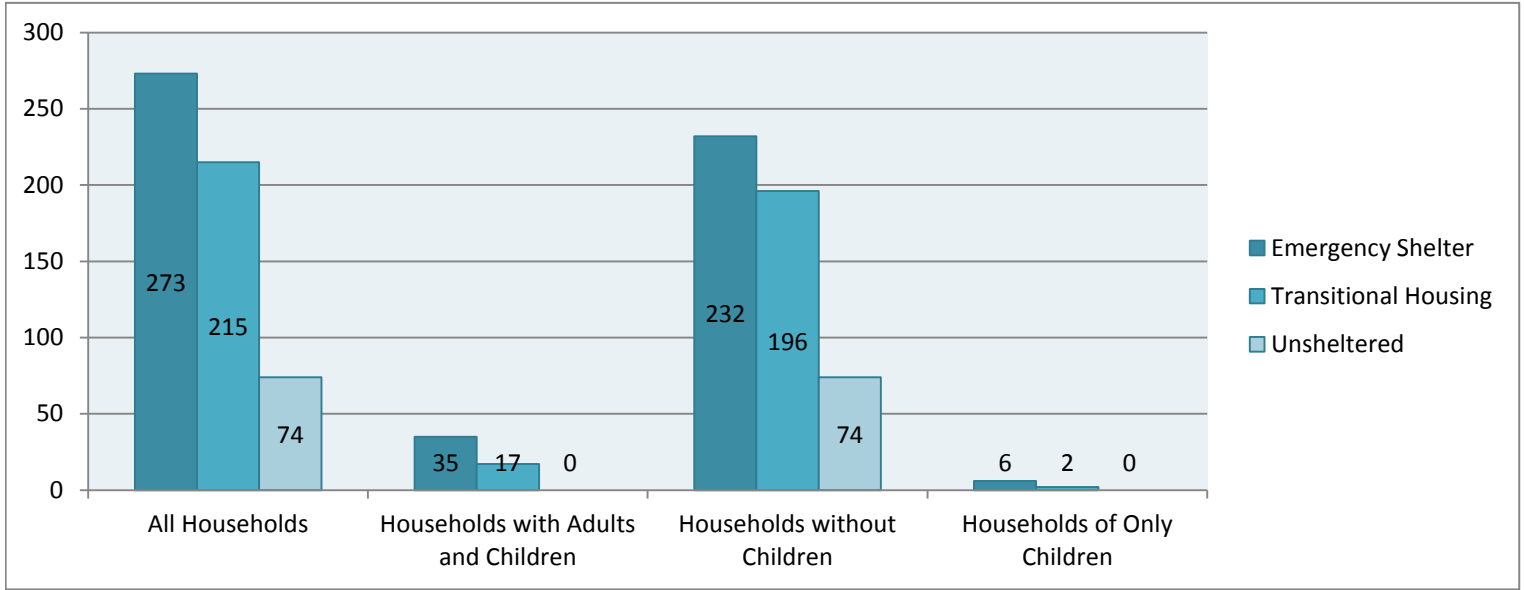

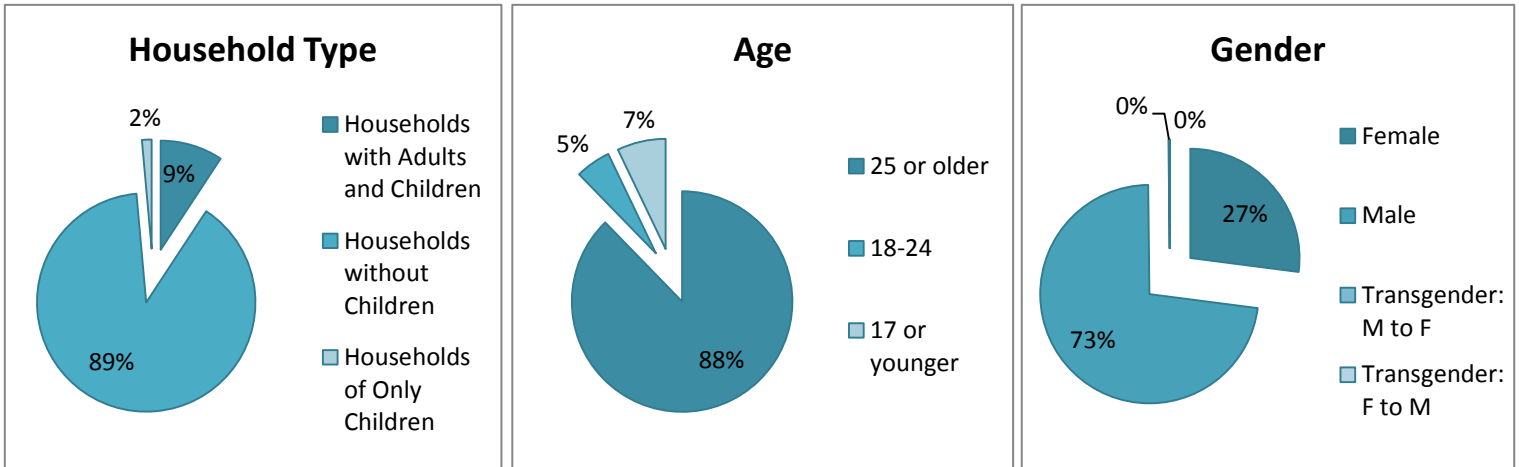


# 2015 Point-in-Time Count Data: Buncombe Continuum of Care

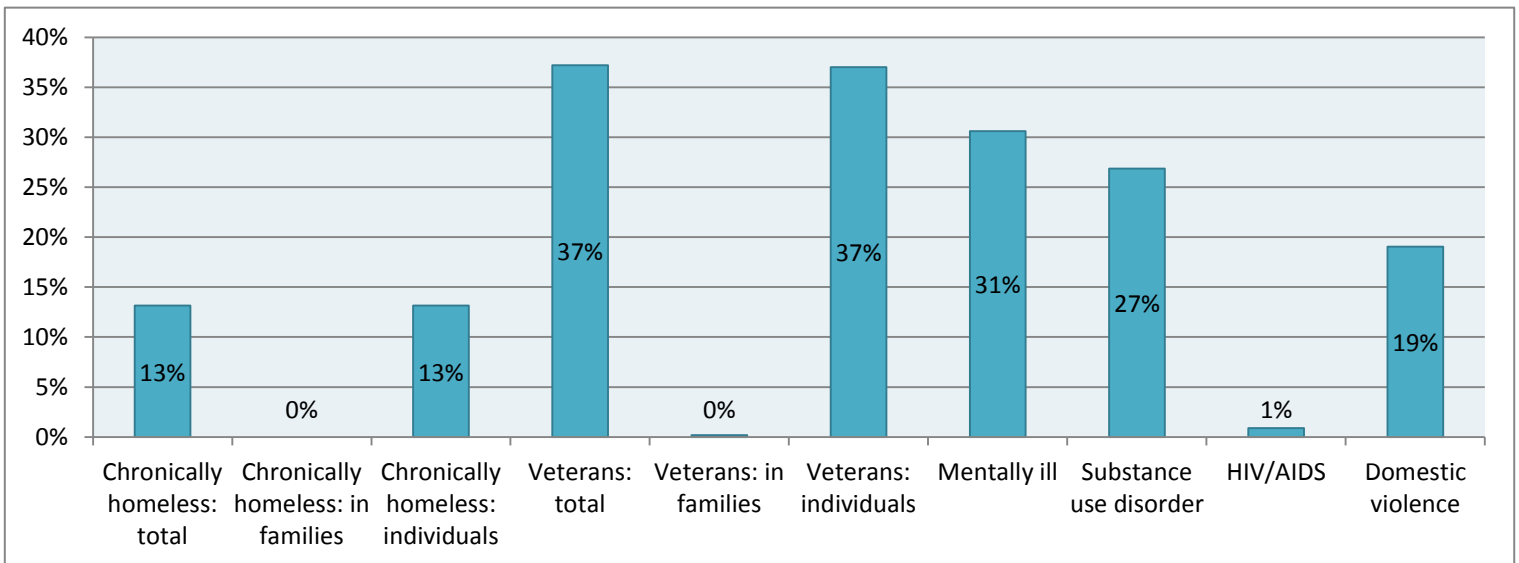
## 2015 Homeless Count by Living Situation



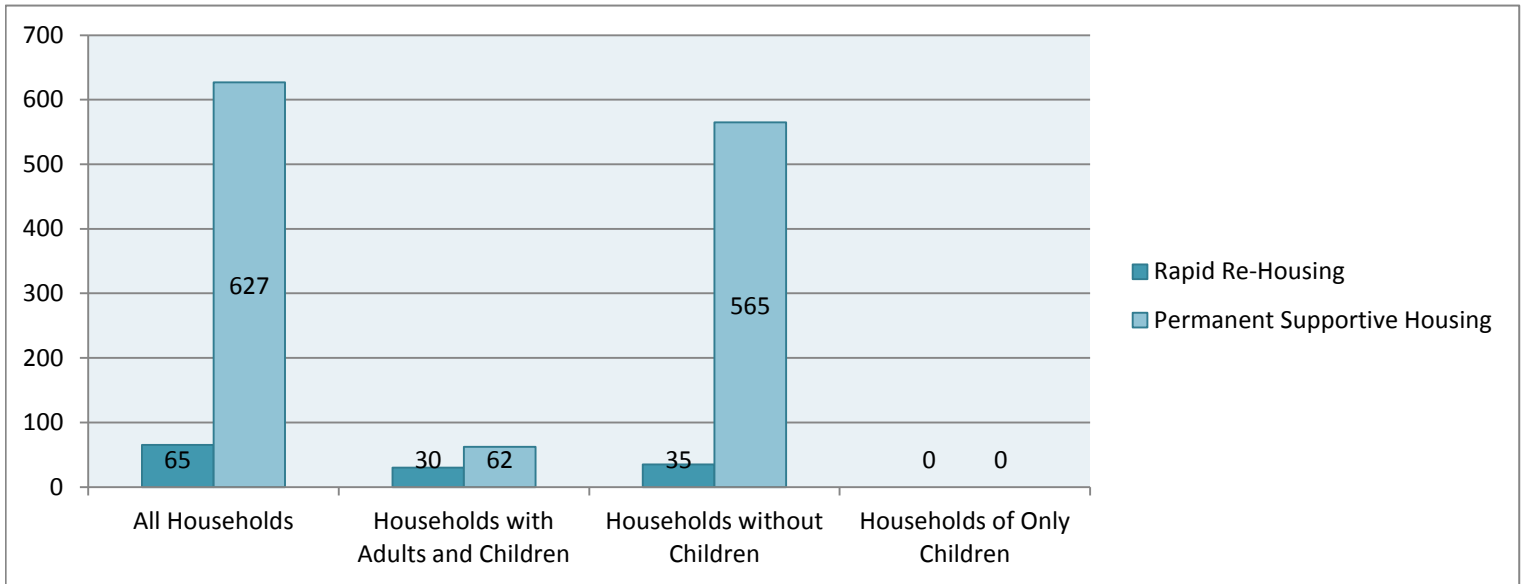
## 2015 Homeless Count Demographics



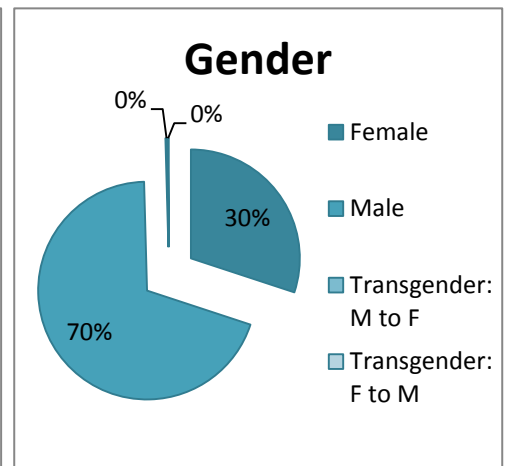
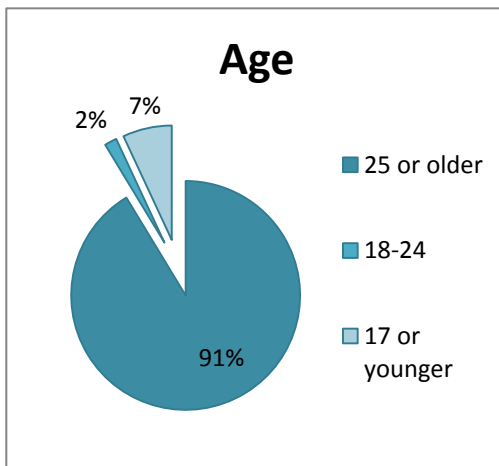
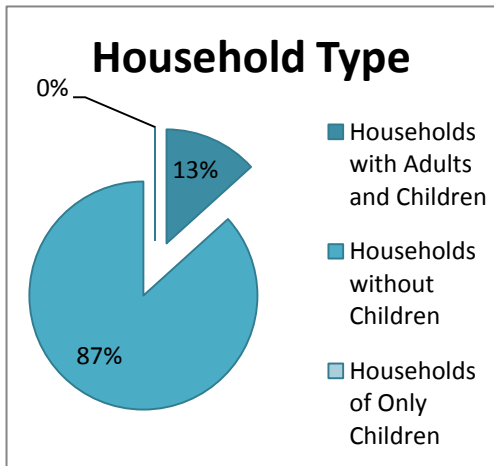
## 2015 Homeless Count Subpopulations
