VI-SPDAT version 2

BoS will be changing from version 1 to version 2 of VI-SPDAT on Jan. 1, 2016

- Changes to VI-SPDAT version 2
 - Incorporates feedback Orgcode got from the field
 - Specifically around DV elements
 - Shorter, fewer questions
 - Takes on average 7 minutes rather than 9 minutes
 - Removed subjective measures
 - Evaluators making judgment calls based on observation

 - December or January


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Some data of note from CA Outcome forms

 - P/D screen more neutral


The Prevention/Diversion screen is successful in triaging households in housing crises.




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Strongly Disagree: 1 0 0%

Regional Committees identified many challenges and system gaps

- Participation
- System flow
- Resources
 - Affordable housing
- Alignment with HUD priorities
 - Homeless definition
 - Prioritization
- Community/other agency education
- Tracking and reporting data
- Not implementing fully

Plan change policy

We expect coordinated assessment to change over time

- Changes to plans are expected
- Some changes made at local level, some required CAC approval


