Cabarrus County reported 140 people; 56% women & children

Homeless Indicator Dashboard:

Mike Wojciechowski - CCM has established a schedule for agencies reporting indicators so that Dashboards can be prepared and distributed on a regular quarterly basis.

Community Link suggested that we look into developing a “positive indicators” report

Discussion pointed toward an annual Homelessness Report that will highlight successes.

Suggestion to survey Property Managers in Cabarrus County to gain insight into what is causing homelessness.

Foster Care – Young adults aging out of foster care needing a housing solution (18-24 yrs old)
