Eligibility

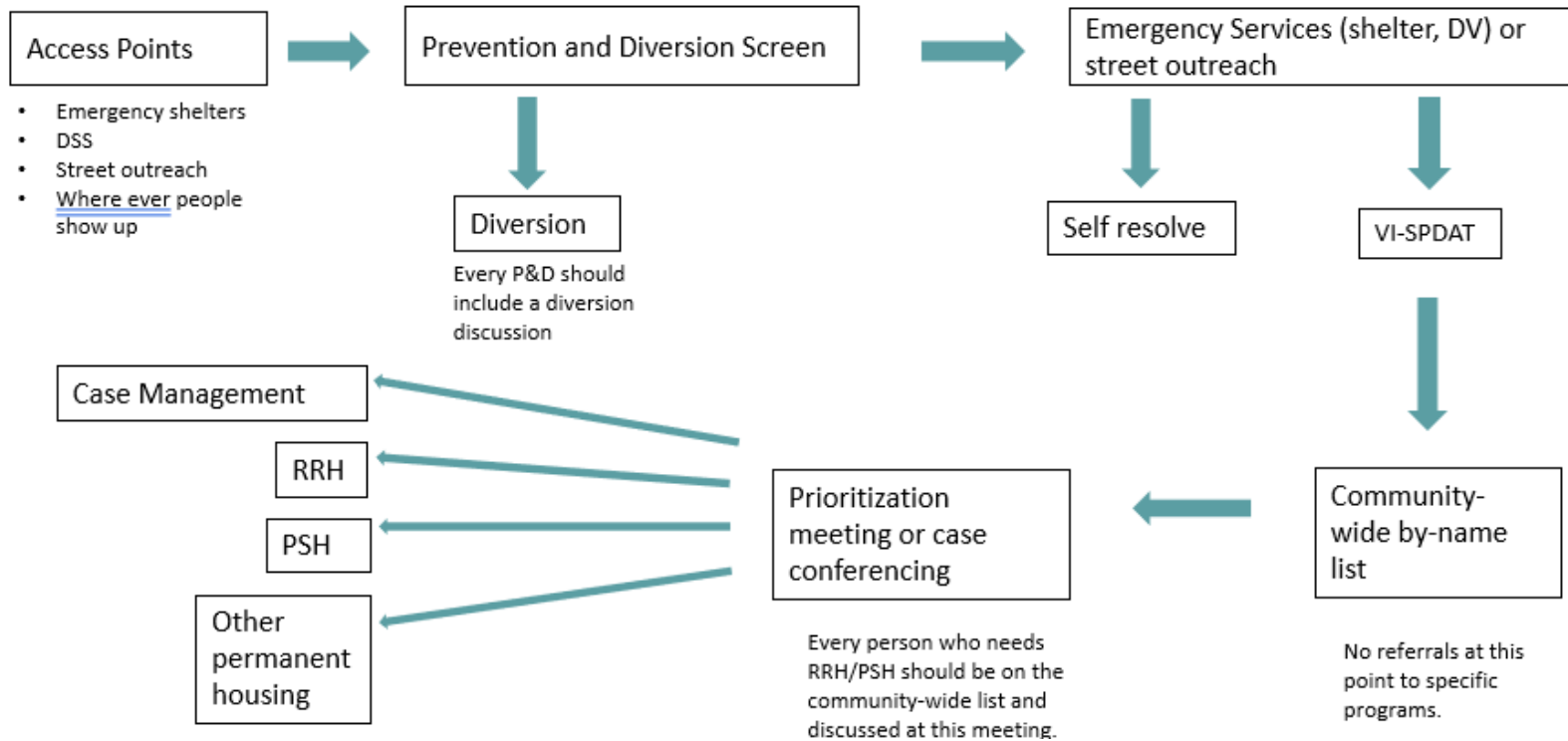
Client eligibility

- All clients must be category 1, 2, or 4 under HUD's homeless definition.
- Category 1 clients will go into the Coordinated Entry workflow
- Category 2 clients will go into the Prevention and Diversion workflow
- Category 4 clients can be assessed and referred to appropriate resources



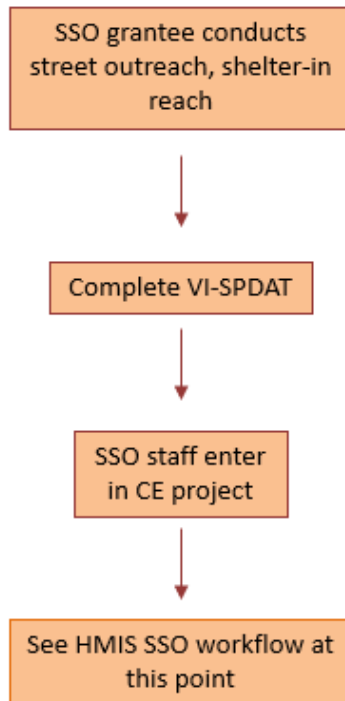

Coordinated Entry Overview

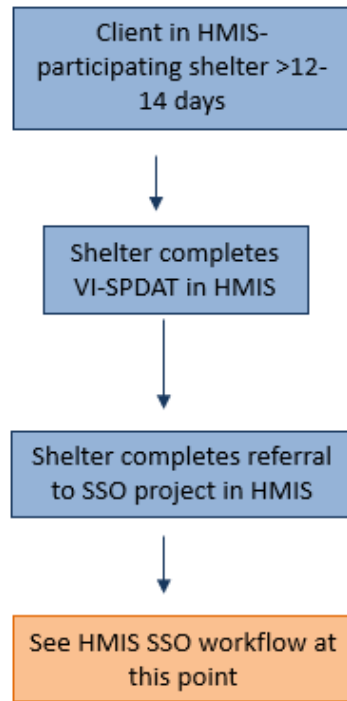


Paths to Coordinated Entry Project:

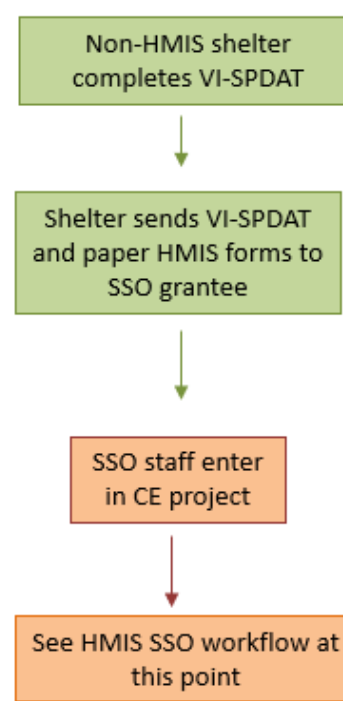
1: SSO grantee workflow



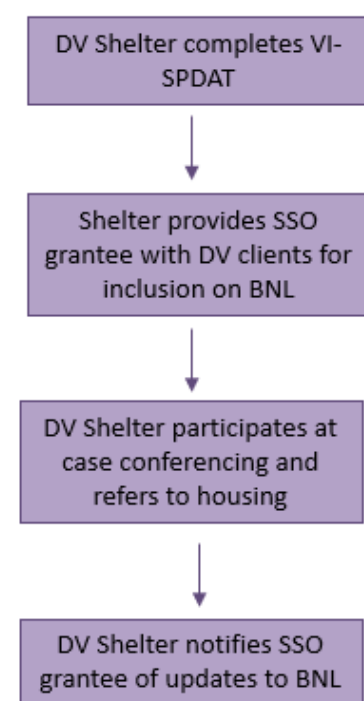
2: HMIS shelter workflow



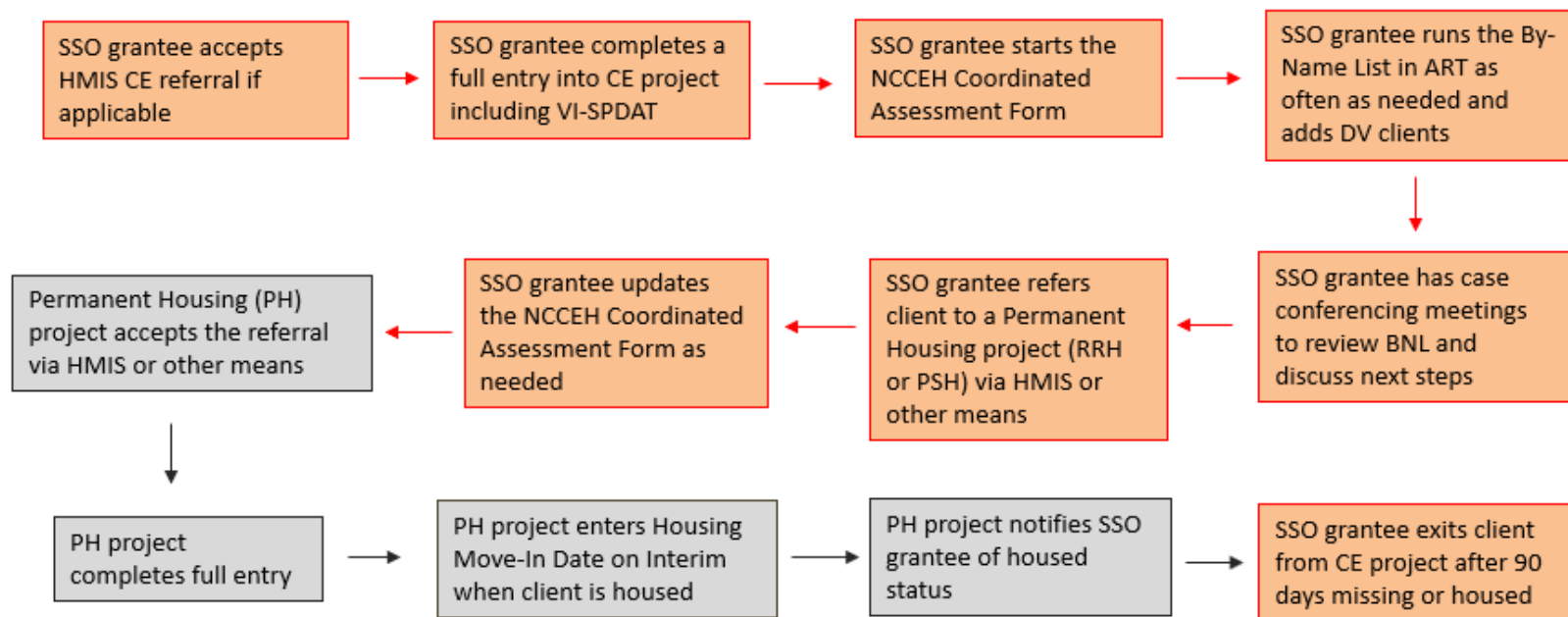
3: Non-HMIS shelter workflow

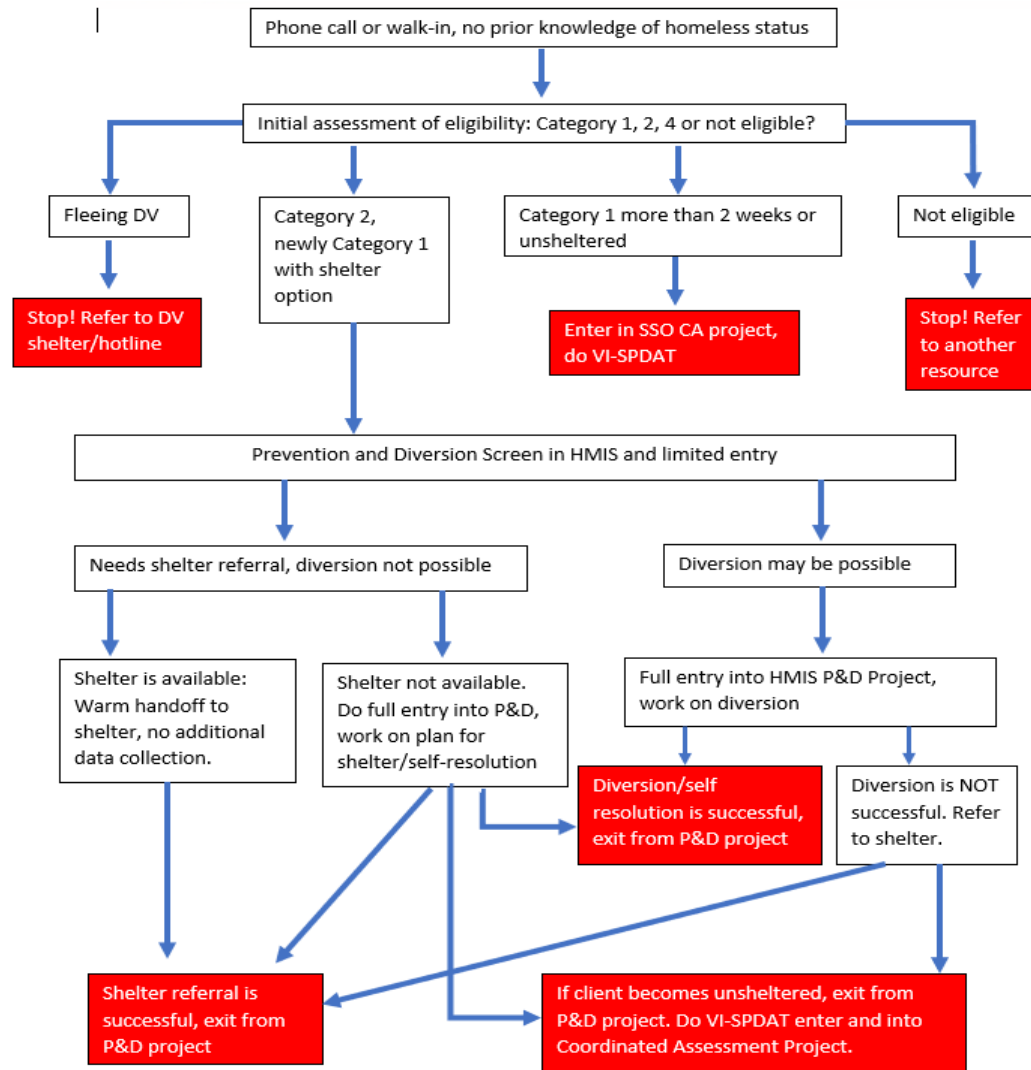
