Background Information: Statewide organizations have wanted better information for understanding the entire population experiencing homelessness in NC. This has never been developed from de-duplicated HMIS data (since 2015). The four HMIS Implementations have been meeting for about two years to develop with the help of HUD TA with ICF, a statewide data warehouse. A Request for Proposal is ready for community review and publishing!

Background Information: Every year HUD requires CoCs to conduct an annual census of those experiencing homelessness, whether or not people are connected to services or their service providers are funded by federal agencies. HUD requires that the night for the count be in the last ten days of January to provide some year-to-year consistency. It must be the same night for the whole CoC. Page 25 of the most recent PIT/HIC Notice (attached) explains: CoCs are required to conduct a PIT count at least biennially during the last 10 days of January. CoCs that are considering performing their required PIT count outside of the last 10 days of January must request a PIT count date exception from HUD. No HUD permission or exception is required for CoCs to conduct supplemental PIT counts. CoCs must ensure that their count estimate accurately reflects what they believe to be the entire sheltered and unsheltered population for the CoC's entire geographic area."

Traditionally, NC BoS CoC's Point in Time Count and Housing Inventory Count has been the last Wednesday of January. If we used that date for the 2026 PIT/HIC, that would be January 28th. As part of the work to improve governance, the Steering Committee should have the ultimate decision making power to determine the date.
