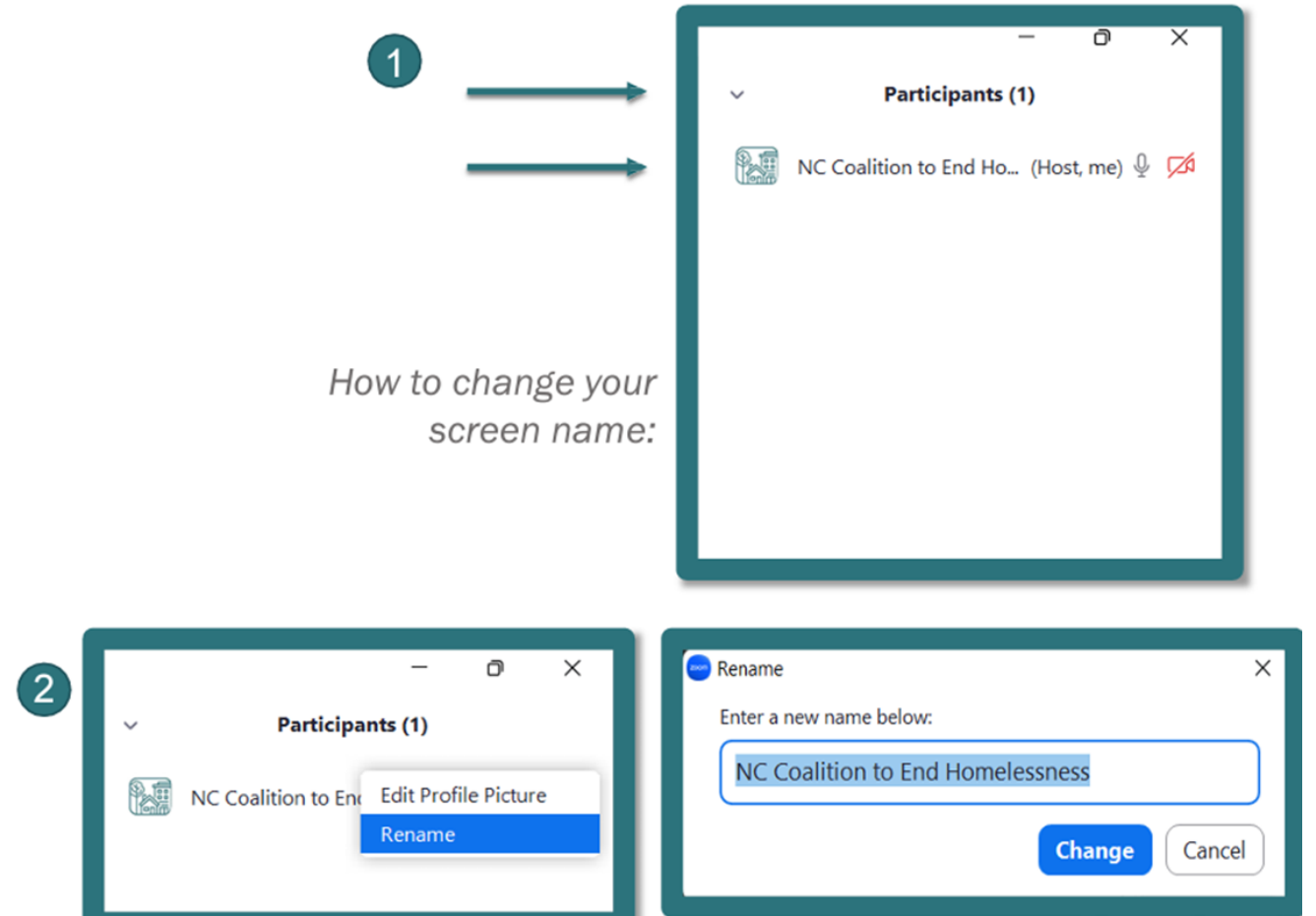


Unsheltered Access Coordinator Planning & Training

- Is there data or support with data we can provide to help with year-round outreach?
- Is there data or support with data we can provide to help with Unsheltered PIT count planning next year?



Future Improvements

- What changes or resources would most improve future unsheltered PIT Counts in your region? (Ideas could include funding for outreach staff, better volunteer systems, more training, stronger data tools)
- Are there any data sources you have access to in that could supplement or complement last year's data?
- What best practices would you recommend to other regions or UACs?
- Do you have a plan to mentor or 'onboard' your region's incoming UAC?
- Any additional comments or insights about unsheltered access or PIT Count engagement?
